

INNOAESTHETICS CLINICAL EVIDENCE PROGRAM

Participation Conditions and Incentives

1. Purpose of the Program

The INNOAESTHETICS Clinical Evidence Program is a global initiative designed to collect and showcase high-quality Before & After clinical cases developed by selected doctors worldwide using INNOAESTHETICS or/and MELINE treatments.

The program aims to:

- showcase outstanding clinical results achieved across different indications and skin phototypes
- increase the international visibility of participating doctors and clinics
- create an international network of high-value clinical cases
- support medical education and scientific activities through real clinical evidence
- collect treatment protocols and clinical approaches developed by doctors worldwide

2. Who Can Participate

The program is open to:

- aesthetic doctors
- dermatologists
- cosmetologists
- officially certified nurses

using INNOAESTHETICS and/or MELINE products in their daily practice.

Participation is reserved for doctors selected by local distributors.

3. Participation Process

To participate, doctors must upload their clinical cases directly through the designated INNOAESTHETICS platform.

Each submission must include:

- Before & After photographs
- treatment protocol
- products used
- brief clinical results summary
- signed patient consent form for the use of photographs

All required fields on the platform must be completed.

Participants must ensure that submitted photographs comply with the quality standards described in the Clinical Photography Guide available on the platform.

4. Validation Criteria

All submitted clinical cases will be reviewed and validated by the INNOAESTHETICS Medical Department.

Only complete and compliant cases will be approved.

The following conditions apply:

- cases must include INNOAESTHETICS and/or MELINE products
- treatments may be combined with other procedures or technologies (laser, radiofrequency, etc.)
- photographs must be authentic and may not be digitally altered or retouched
- image quality must comply with the Clinical Photography Guide
- all required documentation must be provided

INNOAESTHETICS reserves the right to reject incomplete or non-compliant submissions.

5. Visibility & Benefits

Selected and medically validated cases may benefit from:

- publication on official INNOAESTHETICS and MELINE online platforms and social media
- inclusion in educational, scientific and congress materials
- visibility opportunities during international training activities and scientific presentations
- clinical Excellence Certificate issued by INNOAESTHETICS
- exclusive patient-support materials linked to validated cases
- access to an international network of high-value clinical cases

Additional benefits may apply depending on the level of participation and the number of approved cases.

Once cases have been validated, the distributor from the doctor's country will contact participants regarding the corresponding benefits and participation follow-up.

6. Patient Consent & Data Protection

Participants are responsible for complying with all applicable local regulations regarding patient privacy, personal data protection and image rights.

Before submitting any clinical case, participants must:

- obtain signed patient consent for the use of photographs
- inform patients regarding data processing and image usage
- ensure compliance with all applicable legal and ethical requirements

Participants guarantee the confidentiality of patient personal data.

7. Image Usage Rights

By participating in the program and submitting clinical cases, participants authorize INNOAESTHETICS to use the approved images and related clinical information exclusively for:

- scientific purposes
- educational purposes
- training purposes
- congress presentations
- corporate and promotional communication related to the program

No patient-identifiable information will be disclosed.

Before any use of the images, INNOAESTHETICS may adapt them, when necessary, in order to avoid showing patient-identifiable features, prioritizing the framing of the treated area, unless such features are necessary to properly assess the clinical result.

Withdrawal of consent for the use of patient photographs

If a patient wishes to withdraw the consent granted for the use of their photographs, they must send a written request by email to their doctor or clinic, copying LABORATORIO INNOAESTHETICS, S.L.U. at florencia.couce@innoaesthetics.com.

Once the request has been received, INNOAESTHETICS will stop using those photographs for any new uses. Withdrawal of consent shall not have retroactive effect and shall not affect any previous lawful uses made on the basis of the consent granted by the patient.
